

QuakeCoRE Research Masters Scholarships

Applications Close: Noon, Friday 21 October 2022

What

 1 to 2 year Master's Scholarships for students studying in the field of earthquake resilience, applicants must start this scholarship no later than six months from the date of the Scholarship Award Letter(Scholarship Outcomes will be announced in December 2022).

Who

- Outstanding undergraduate candidates studying with a primary supervisor that is a QuakeCoRE Programme Area Leader (PAL) or Associate Investigator (AI)
- Students must be graduating within less than six (6) of the time applications close to be eligible. In most cases application will be prior to starting their Masters
- We are accepting applications for one or two-year Master's research scholarships only. Applications for Research Assistants and existing Masters students within projects will be considered via the RfP (details here).
- Applications PhD scholarships will be considered via a separate scholarship application process, (details here).

When

 Applications are due by Noon on Friday 21 October, 2022; no late applications will be accepted.
