

QuakeCoRE PhD Scholarships

Applications Close: Noon, Friday 21 October 2022

What

- 3 year PhD Scholarships for students studying in the field of earthquake resilience, applicants must start this scholarship no later than six months from the date of the Scholarship Award Letter (Scholarship Outcomes will be announced in December 2022).

Who

- Outstanding PhD Candidates studying with a primary supervisor that is a QuakeCoRE Programme Area Leader or Associate Investigator
- Students must not have completed more than six (6) months of their PhD at the time applications close to be eligible. In most cases application will be prior to starting PhD.

When

- We are currently accepting applications for three-year scholarships only, applications for new Masters Scholarships is available through a separate process and funding for existing PhD Students is available via the RfP (details on both are [here](#)).
- Applications are due by Noon on Friday 21 October, 2022; no late applications will be accepted.
